

## **Procedure for the admission test**

Bachelor Health Informatics

### **Approval procedure:**

- Please apply online to Deggen Dorf Institute of Technology. The application period for the winter semester begins on April 15 and ends on Juli 15.
- As an applicant for the Bachelor's degree programme Health Informatics, you qualify with proof of a certified university entrance qualification.
- Proof of the following language skills must be provided for this study programme:
  - English: Unless English is the native language, proof of level B2 English skills according to the Common European Framework Reference for Languages must be provided.

Regarding proof of language skills, the regulations set forth in Sec. 3 of the General Examination Regulations for Additional Qualification in Foreign Languages and Compulsory Elective Subjects of a General Academic Nature of Deggen Dorf Institute of Technology, as amended from time to time, shall apply.

### **Informationen on the admission test:**

- The application for the admission test must be submitted and uploaded with the application documents in the online application process. You can find the document for the application for the admission test on the homepage and in the online application tool.
- The test is intended to prove the ability to work scientifically and therefore to determine whether the special qualitative requirements for the successful completion of the Bachelor's programme in Health Informatics are met.
- The following criteria are considered for aptitude assessment. :
  1. Average grade of the higher education entrance qualification
  2. Written test:

The written online test, which has a duration of 90 minutes, contains questions from the mathematical, information technology and physical, biological subject areas of the study programme. The written test takes place in presence or online-based.

Admission is only granted if the higher education entrance qualification is available and the written online test has been passed.

- Online-Test

If you are unable to take the test in person at our European Campus Rottal-Inn, an online test is available at your convenience. The online test will be proctored by an external service provider and as such will incur a small fee. Payment has to be made with an internationally accepted credit card. In order to take the online test, you must register with ProctorU. You mustn't register with DIT for the online test.

ProctorU is a live online proctoring service that allows you to take your exam from the comfort of your home. ProctorU provides a platform with multi-factor identity verification and end-to-end video recording with AI based behavior flagging. Test-takers are guided through the entire process by a live proctor who can also assist with technical issues. ProctorU is available 24/7; however, you will need to schedule your proctoring session at least 72 hours in advance to avoid any additional on-demand scheduling fees.

In order to use ProctorU, you will need a high-speed internet connection, a webcam (internal or external), a windows or apple Operating System, and a government issued photo id.

At the scheduled day and time of your test, you must login to ProctorU. You will be guided through the next necessary steps and the proctor will unlock the actual admission test. It is crucial that you have your username and password (provided via-mail) at hand.

Once you have started the test, you will have 90 minutes to complete it. The proctor is unable to pause the clock for any reason. This is why we highly recommend that you ensure that your connection is stable for the duration of the online admission test.

- Result of the aptitude assessment:  
Applicants who obtain 101 points or more are admitted. Applicants with an overall assessment of 100 or less points receive a rejection notice. Further Information is available on our Homepage. (Link: [Study and Examination Regulations](#))
- The procedure for determining suitability for a specific degree programme is carried out yearly in the summer semester for the following winter semester. Applications for admission to the procedure, together with the application documents, must be submitted to the Deggendorf Institute of Technology in the online application procedure by the end of the application period, latest by July 15<sup>th</sup>. (cut-off-deadline).
- Applicants who have not provided proof of their course-specific eligibility can re-register for the test once more on the date of the following year. In justified exceptional cases, it is possible to register for the test at a later date. It is not possible to retake the test at a later date.
