He is a teacher and researcher at DIT-ECRI. He is a consultant in Standards for Interoperability of Medical Informatics projects of national, regional, local, and organizational scope. He is also a Senior Advisor in Interamerican Development Bank for Digital Transformation projects. He participates in working committees of different organizations that work for the development of health interoperability standards such as HL7 int, Monitor of European Connectathons of IHE, Member forum at SNOMED CT, and a member of the RACSEL Regional Technical Committee.

Fernando is involved in the Management and direction of work teams, as well as in the implementation and implantation of technological projects of health information systems (Electronic Medical Record, Laboratory, Medical Imaging, pharmacy, UCIS, blood bank, operating rooms, public health, among others). He is an active participant in collaborative networks for the development of knowledge of health informatics. He is recipient of the ANTEL Health Innovation Award (Montevideo Uruguay).
