Regulations for writing a bachelor or master's thesis

- 1. A bachelor or master's thesis is to be written in compliance with the State Examination Regulations in Bavaria (RaPO), the General Examination Regulations (APO) of Deggendorf Institute of Technology and the Study and Examination Regulations, each in their most recent version as amended from time to time.¹
- 2. The thesis is to be written using a text processing system:
 - 2.1. The number of pages may be specified by the relevant examiner. Failing this, students can prepare their thesis based on the following guidelines: font size: 11 pt, single-space lines; approx. 50 pages for a bachelor's thesis; approx. 80 pages for a master's thesis. Where applicable, a source code or similar is to be attached as an appendix.
 - 2.2. A title page, as per the attached example, is to precede the actual thesis. The topic of the thesis is to be cited on the title page in both English and German.
 - 2.3. The thesis must include a full and complete bibliography and list all obtained information as well as all other sources used. The relevant literature should be consulted to ascertain the specific formal requirements to be observed.
 - 2.4. In accordance with Section 35 (7) RaPO, the candidate is required to attach a written declaration confirming that the thesis is the result of their own work, has been written without the assistance of others, and that every resource used to complete it has been cited. A sample declaration is attached as Appendix 2 (1) to these regulations. Should the declaration be directly incorporated into the thesis, it must be located at the end of the work.
 - 2.5. A declaration of consent permitting the work to be used free of charge within the university is to be provided on a printed form as shown in Appendix 2 (2).
 - 2.6. The student's given name, surname, matriculation number and the dissertation topic are to be stated in full on the front and, where necessary, in abridged form on the back of the page.
 - 2.7. The thesis is to be compiled as a PDF document and saved using the following structure <Surname>-<Given name>-<Bachelor|Master's>thesis.pdf
- 3. Where applicable, other regulations as well as specifications provided by the thesis examiner are to be observed.
- 4. The process for registering to write the thesis occurs through the Primuss system.
- 5. Submission of thesis:
 - 5.1. The submitted copies of the thesis remain at the Institute.
 - 5.2. The thesis is to be uploaded as a PDF file to the Primuss system (if uploading issues arise, alternatively by e-mail to the Centre for Studies). It is recommended that students additionally submit a PDF version of the thesis directly to the examiner by e-mail or in the manner specified by the examiner.
