

First PLV week (Career Service seminars)

The first PLV is replaced by seven Career Service seminars. Every student enrolled in the "Electronics Engineering for Artificial Intelligence - International" program must have completed four seminars from the "Study and Personal Skills" section and three seminars from the "Professional Skills" section by the time they reach their practical semester.

In this degree program it is up to you whether you want to attend the seminar in English or German.

After each seminar you have attended, you receive a signature from the lecturer on the confirmation form. The confirmation form for each seminar must be uploaded to the internship database in PRIMUSS (My Studies / Internship Management) at least two weeks before the start of the 6th semester (practical semester) with all signatures in place. The Career Service will check the confirmation form for accuracy and completeness. The check mark for "PLV 1 completed" will then be set. Students are responsible for completing the seven seminars before the start of the internship.
